Kriyayoga Ashram Constantly spreads the Message of Kriyayoga

There is a hidden golden, all-pervading heat, a symbol of the great unity that lies within black charcoal. When charcoal touches the spark of fire, hidden golden Omnipotent heat starts radiating around which results in the conversion of black charcoal into golden red. Exactly in the same way, the darkness of the human being is transformed into even-minded, golden light when a person is in contact with Kriyayoga. There is an essential need to spread Kriyayoga to all countries of the world in order to charge them with the spiritual strength along with the worldly riches. International spiritual leader, Swami Shree Yogi Satyam, delivered this message to pilgrims attending the Kriyayoga Camp at Mukti Marg in Kumbha Mela.

Swamiji further said that Kriyayoga will unite all countries together by removing war from the face of the earth. It will only be possible when Kriyayoga is accepted and practiced by the majority of Indians. Paramahansa Yogananda worked in spreading the Kriyayoga message to North America but he realized that without spreading it in India, it would be difficult to spread the glory of Kriyayoga all over the world. Therefore, he decided to complete his mission in North America and then enter into mahasamadhi with the aim to be re-born again in India.

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In order to fulfill his mission, a banquet was organized at the Biltmore Hotel, in Los Angeles, California, on March 7, 1952 where foreign delegates of fifty nations were present. At the banquet, Paramahansa Yogananda delivered his last message and prophesied his future work. He forecasted, "O India, I will be there," and entered into mahasamadhi (conscious final exit from the body). Prior to his mahasamadhi, Paramahansa had a conversation with disciples at the Lake Shrine Ashram informing them that thirty years after his departure Kriyayoga will start again with a strong force. Just after thirty years, the Kriyayoga Ashram was established in Allahabad, which is the largest populated spiritual place in the world and also in the same year Yog Fellowship Temple located in Kitchener, Ontario, Canada was also established. Now both centers are connected with each other like fire and heat within fire.

The Kriyayoga Ashram in Jhansi, Allahabad is fully dedicated to all in providing Kriyayoga classes to all. Kriyayoga classes are conducted at three different locations. At the Kriyayoga Camp at Mukti Marg in Kumbha Mela, classes are conducted at 8 to 10 a.m. and 2:30 to 6 p.m. At Kali Road, classes are conducted from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. At Mori Road, class is at 11 p.m. to 1 a.m. All are most welcome to attend and participate in the Kriyayoga classes.

Many Kriyayoga devotees have been attending these classes and have travelled from all over India and the world, including countries such as England, Russia, Canada, USA, Brazil, Italy, Germany, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Australia, France, etc.
